

Dear Miss Canellopoulou,

We are looking forward to seeing you at Merton for the academic year 1995-96. As Tutor for Graduate Admissions, it is my duty at this point to check that all graduates coming into residence have funds to cover the whole duration of their Oxford course and the other attendant expenses. (This also means that if you have been admitted for a two-year course - e.g. M.Phil., M.Litt., etc. - you will be unable to transfer to D.Phil. status unless a further year's funding is assured). I should be grateful if you could let me have, as soon as possible, written details of your funding for **fees and maintenance** including the sources and duration of any grants or bursaries. If you have obtained an established award such as a State Studentship, EPSRC award, Rhodes Scholarship, etc., a copy of the letter advising you of the award is all that is required. If you intend to fund yourself privately, the College requires confirmation from your bank, building society or any private individuals who intend to help you with funding.

I am sorry to trouble you with these requests, but the College has to be sure that its graduate students are properly provided for, in order to avoid hardship and disappointment at a later stage.
